CURRENT DUI

Driving Under the Influence (DUI): This is the client's **first** DUI violation in the last 10 years. This means he could be subject to: incarceration (jail or prison), a fine, suspended driver's license, possible Ignition Interlock Device (IID) installation, and completion of a mandated state licensed DUI education/counseling program. Under some conditions, a restricted driver's license may be issued. **If probation is granted, incarceration time, fines and the duration of state licensed DUI education/counseling program involvement can vary.** And additional enhancements may increase the client's DUI-related penalties.

Chemical (Breath, Blood, Urine) Tests. The client's Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) level at the time of his arrest was 0.09%. BAC levels at or above the legal limit of 0.08% have serious consequences. And additional penalties can accrue when the driver's impairment status, driving records and applicable enhancements are taken into account.

ENHANCEMENTS

Enhancements are serious aggravating circumstances that can influence DUI sentencing provisions and penalties. The client's DUI enhancement(s) are self reported.

- **Minor (Under 14) Passenger in DUI Vehicle:** A DUI or DUID client with a minor passenger could face up to 6 months in the county jail, a fine and may have to surrender their driver's license to the court.
- **1 Alcohol (Not DUI) Arrests in the Last 10 Years.** The strong correlation between the number of alcohol-related arrests and the DII Alcohol Scale score demonstrated discriminant validity.
- **Double-Fine Zone Enhancement:** The DUI or DUID client may be given increased fines and penalties for DUIs that occur in double fine (construction, maintenance or safety) zones.
- **What Are Enhancements?** California's DUI laws incorporate sentence enhancements (increased penalty severity), which can be imposed due to serious aggravating circumstances or DUI/DUID-related events.

Adults (21 and Older): Adult DUI and DUID penalties can include: (a) mandatory jail time, (b) substantial fines and fees, (c) suspension or revocation of one's driver license, (d) restrictions on when and for what purposes you may drive, (e) being assigned to a California licensed DUI education/counseling or treatment program, (f) in some cases the installation of an ignition interlock device on your car, and (g) possible impoundment of your vehicle ("Driver Education Curriculum" www.dmv.ca.gov/pubs/curriculum/Unit%2010.pdf - 2009-01-07). In addition, applicable enhancements (aggravating circumstances) can result in increased severity of penalties.

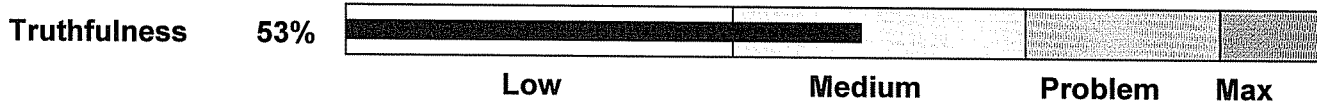
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Truthfulness Scale

Medium Risk Percentile: 53%

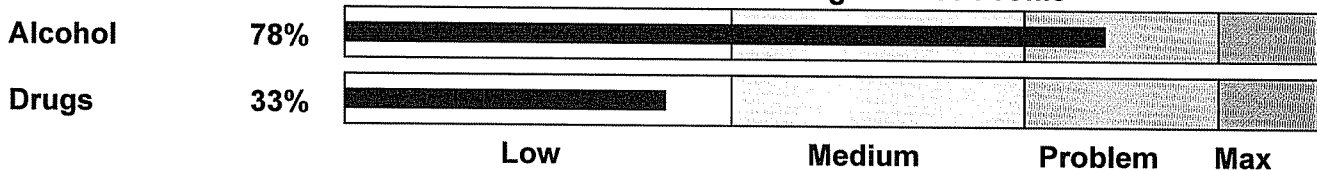
This client's Truthfulness Scale score is within the medium range. Although there is a tendency for this person to portray self in an overly favorable light, this DII profile is accurate. More specifically, the Alcohol Scale and Drugs Scale scores are accurate. Also this client has adequate reading abilities.

This individual's Truthfulness Scale score is in the medium (40 to 69th percentile) range. Medium risk scorers' DII scale scores are accurate.

Alcohol Scale

Problem Risk Percentile: 78%

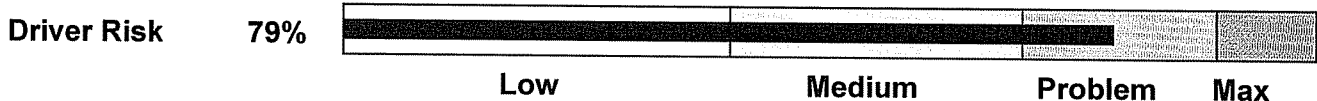
This client's Alcohol Scale score is in the Problem Risk (70th to 89th percentile) range. Growing alcohol involvement, problematic drinking behavior and signs of alcohol abuse are becoming evident. Alcohol-related problem severity is in the problem range. Efficacy of state-licensed DUI education and counseling programs increases when the intensity of these programs is matched with problem severity. Without intervention this client's alcohol problem could worsen. Review this client's response to the 'recovering alcoholic' question (#70) and alcohol-related Significant Items that follow. If this individual is recovering, for how long? Relapse risk is elevated. Any applicable enhancements (page 1) may further increase recommended treatment intensity and duration.

Drugs Scale

Low Risk Percentile: 33%

This person's Drugs Scale score is in the Low Risk (zero to 39th percentile) range. Low risk scorers do not engage in repeated drug abuse. Indeed, drug abuse is unlikely and an established pattern of abuse is not indicated. Drug abuse is not a focal issue. However, to protect against wrongly identifying "recovering" (abstainers that have stopped using) drug abusers, precautions have been built-into the DII. Drug use and abuse admissions along with the client's answer to the "recovering" drug user question (#70) are printed in the following Significant Items section. A low intensity state licensed DUI education/counseling program is recommended. Applicable "enhancements" could increase the severity of DUI-related penalties.

Driver Risk Scale

Problem Risk Percentile: 79%

The client's Driver Risk Scale score is in the problem (70 to 89th percentile) range. Problem risk scorers are often impatient, quick tempered, careless and easily angered. While driving, these emotions could interfere with The client's judgment, psychomotor performance and driving skills. Check the other DII scales. Alcohol and drug abuse problems could directly affect the client's driving. A driver safety course could be beneficial.

Significant Items: Significant Items represent self admissions or important self-report responses. They are provided for reference and do not by themselves determine the respondent's scale score. For example, a person could have a high scale score and few significant items. Significant Items are printed for the Alcohol, Drugs and Driver Risk scales. Significant Items augment scale scores and sometimes provide a more complete understanding of the client. Significant Items permit comparison of the client's beliefs and attitude with their objective scale scores.

Alcohol Scale Significant Items:

- 25. Drinking is a problem
- 37. States drinking serious problem
- 52. Needs help with drinking problem
- 30. Admits to drinking problem
- 41. Attends AA meetings

Drugs Scale Significant Items:

- 8. Concerned about drug use
- 43. Last year cravings for drugs
- 22. Relative said "get help"

Driver Risk Scale Significant Items:

- 6. Client admits to quick temper
- 20. Client gets angry quickly
- 35. Admits is a risk prone driver
- 47. Driver attitude problems
- 12. Admits is an aggressive driver
- 27. States often loses control
- 42. Yells or argues when annoyed

Driver Impairment Index-Dr (DII-Dr). The comprehensive three-page DII-Dr report provides a great deal of useful information about DUI or DUID client status in terms of California's DUI sentencing system (number of DUI's, chemical test results and enhancements) while also screening for alcohol and drug use severity and driver risk. All DII-Dr scale scores are presented and explained on page two of the report, including the Truthfulness Scale, which evaluates the client's level of truthfulness while completing the DII-Dr and identifies client denial or problem minimization. Significant DII-Dr test items are also noted. The DII-Dr, developed exclusively for California DUI/DUID client evaluation, is designed to work smoothly with California's current DUI system and statutes.
